



Organization Renewal Scholarship Application Guide

**What's the purpose
of these
Scholarships?**

While Personal Renewal Scholarships are about taking care of you, Organizational Scholarships are about investing money in others in your organization and / or professional community in an effort to affect renewal and change in the youth-serving organizations in which you lead and participate.

**What are
acceptable ways to
spend the money?**

The litmus test is: can you make the case that your request will result in renewal and transformation for other professionals in the field? Does it do something for your organization, now and will it likely lead to a better organization in the future?

**What's the
application process
for receiving and
accounting for the
money?**

Executive Fellows must submit an application which includes basic information, plans, rationale and an estimated budget. Once it is approved, a check for \$500 will be sent to your organization (or you, in rare instances). You will be required to furnish a final accounting of how you spent all funds, prior to the close of the program year.
