

Courage To Lead is based upon the work of Parker J. Palmer, PhD and the principles and practices of Courage To Teach, a national program of renewal for teachers.




Each of the three retreats will begin at 6 pm on Thursday and end by 3 pm on Saturday.

Participants will enjoy modern, private, single-room accommodations at all retreats, which will be held in natural settings that are both comfortable and inspiring, allowing leaders to get away from everyday distractions and encouraging personal reflection and meaningful conversation.

Participants must commit to participating in all retreats as a member of a cohort learning group.

What is the participation cost?

The cost for leaders is \$1200 for the series of three retreats, and includes program, materials, meals and lodging during the retreats. To ensure that costs do no prohibit participation, the following options are available:

- ◆ An early-bird rate of \$1100 for the series is available to those who register by February 15, 2008.
- ◆ Payment in installments, if required.
- ◆ Limited scholarship support may be available.
